Reporting concerns around sexual and London psychological safety

NHS England is committed to ensuring the safety of all clinicians on a training placement or programme in the clinical learning environment. If you wish to report any concerns for yours or anyone else's sexual or psychological safety, we recommend the steps below:



 In the clinical learning environment: speak to a senior clinician/educational supervisor/ward manager, or Freedom to Speak Up Guardian



 If no resolution with STEP 1: contact your programme director, personal tutor, link tutor, Head of School, Educational Institution, or Higher Education Institution (HEI)



 If no resolution after STEP 1 and 2: please contact the London Education Quality team via england.qrimanagement@nhs.net.
 Please include as much detail as possible, including what steps have been taken to escalate the concern locally
